MINUTES OF THE GENERAL BODY MEETING OF THE PAKISTAN BOTANICAL SOCIETY HELD AT QUAID-I-AZAM UNIVERSITY, ISLAMABAD ON 2ND SEPTEMBER, 2012

The general body meeting of the Pakistan Botanical Society was held on 2nd of September, 2012 in the Geophysics Auditorium, Quaid-i-Azam University, Islamabad. The meeting started with the recitation of a few verses from the Holy Quran. The majority of the PBS members attended the meeting presided over by Professor Dr. Zabta Khan Shinwari, the president of the PBS and assisted by Prof Dr. Asghari Bano, the Secretay General and Treasurer of the PBS. Questions/Answers and Discussion Session was conducted well by the PBS president and secretary. and finally the meeting was concluded with a very warm applause from all members of the PBS. It was unanimously agreed that the next meeting of the PBS will be held at KP Agriculture University, Peshawar with the cooperation of the University of Peshawar. It was also decided that Baluchistan Quetta will be assisted to hold a mini-symposium of the Pakistan Botanical Society under the umbrella of the present PBS leadership.

Many members lauded the efforts of the present leadership for not only holding the conference successfully but in fact well before the given timeline. The general body also appreciated awarding our elders with life-time achievement awards and hoped that at least one such award would be given in each conference. The general body thanked the Vice Chancellor, QAU, for hosting the conference and sponsoring Quaid-i-Azam medals andshields. It is hoped that the PBS successors will follow suit to encourage young plant scientist.
