The meeting started with the recitation of Holy verses, and the following points were discussed:

- Tentative Date of 10th International & 19th National Conference of Plant Science: Dr.
 Rehana Kausar briefed the audience about the prevailing situation of Azad Jammu &
 Kashmir University and talked about the expected VC ship change in June 2025 after
 completion of present VC tenure. Keeping in view the situation of host university and
 arrival of new Vice Chancellor, it was decided unanimously that next conference will be
 held in April 2026 at King Abdullah Campus of UAJK.
- 2. Next Conference Title/Topic: Different topics were discussed by the members and the house finally decided the next conference titled as "Botanical Resources to address food security under climate change scenario".
- 3. Funding Sources: The house thoroughly discussed about the scarcity of funding sources as witnessed in past. Finally, it was decided that for next conference each and every funding source should be touched well before time including HEC, PSF, PAS, Industry, R&D institutions, Corporate sector, Banks, University own sources, Private businesses.
- 4. Life Membership Fee of Botanical Society of Pakistan for Students: During the meeting, it was discussed about the present fee structure for Life Members of Botanical society of Pakistan. Dr. Ejaz-ul-Islam Dar pointed about the revision of this structure for Student category. Finally, it was decided that Rs 10,000/- will be the Life Membership Fee for Students only. Rest of the fee structure will remain intact.
- 5. Recorded lectures of Foreign Presenters: During the last conference at Multan, there was noticed that few foreign presenters couldn't give talks due to sudden internet connectivity issues. To avoid such a situation in future, house suggested that for next conference the recorded lectures of foreign presenters should be taken before time. It would be mandatory for all foreign/international talks.
